Call for Papers (2nd notice) NAAHoLS at LSA

The 2015 NAAHoLS meeting will again be held in conjunction with the Linguistic Society of America, the American Dialect Society, the American Name Society, the Society for the Study of the Indigenous Languages of the Americas, and the Society for Pidgin and Creole Linguistics. Featured LSA plenary speakers this year include Bruce Hayes (UCLA), David Poeppel (NYU), Carmen Silva-Corvalán (USC), and Alicia Wassink (University of Washington).

The annual meeting will take place in Portland, Oregon from 8-11 January 2015. Further details about the meeting will be available in the coming months.

As in the past, we invite papers relating to any aspect of the history of the language sciences. All presenters must be members of the association (contact the NAAHoLS Secretary for details). Papers will be 20 minutes, with 10 minutes for discussion. Abstracts should be submitted as file attachments (MS Word). The length of the abstract should not exceed 500 words – upon acceptance, a shorter (100-word) abstract will also be requested for the meeting handbook. **The deadline for NAAHoLS abstracts is 1 September 2014.**

Upcoming Conferences

13th International Conference on the History of Language Sciences

Vila Real, Portugal (25-29 August 2014)

The 13th International Conference on the History of Language Sciences (ICHoLS XIII) will be held at the Centro de Estudos em Letras (CEL) of the Universidade de Trás-os-Montes e Alto Douro (UTAD), in Vila Real, Portugal, during 25-29 August 2014.

ICHoLS is the most important platform for researchers working on the history of the language sciences, a field that is still expanding as can be attested by the foundation of scientific societies and the establishment of several specialized journals on the history of the language sciences.

Conferences have taken place every three years since 1978. Previous venues have been Ottawa (1978), Lille (1982), Princeton (1984), Trier (1987), Galway (1990), Washington (1993), Oxford (1996), Fontenay-St. Cloud (1999), São Paulo-Campinas (2002), Urbana-Champaign (2005), Potsdam (2008), and Saint Petersburg (2011).

Papers relating to numerous aspects of the history of language sciences are scheduled, focusing on diverse topic areas ranging from antiquity to the contemporary history of linguistics and from individual case studies to methodological considerations.

The organizers had asked that proposals for papers be made in the form of abstracts of 400 words, including a few pertinent references, in an anonymous Word doc or rtf file accompanying the email communication and addressed to: **ichols-xiii@utad.pt**

The deadline for receipt of abstracts was July 2013, and final selection was to have been made by September 2013, and notification of acceptance was to have been sent before December 2013.
